Five LLRPC members made the trip to central Pennsylvania to shoot in the Palmyra Sportsmen Association's Shootout 2007. This was a 4 day steel match with all falling targets. Competitors could shoot in up to 4 classes; Open Auto, Stock Auto, Open Revolver, and Stock Revolver. Each class had 6 stages with 30 to 35 targets at each stage. Yes there was **lots** of shooting. Rick Hupp displayed his usual magic, winning or finishing well in each class. The other veteran PSA shooter, Pat Murray, shot well but seemed most interested in coaching grandson, Austin Mick and talking with old friends. Austin was shooting well when he had a gun malfunction that dropped his overall score. Rookie shooters (at least to PSA) Fred Smith and myself were at different ends of the success spectrum. Fred scored well in all 4 classes while I had ammo problems which placed me near the bottom of two of the three classes I shot.
