## **Executive Committee**

The Executive Committee met August 25<sup>th</sup> to deal with a few issues. One you may have noticed on the officer listing of this newsletter. Morgan Dague has resigned his position as VP for Pistol and the board has replaced him with Jim Fineran. Morgan will be missed but has still agreed to RO our IDPA matches. Morgan explained that with his return to college his limited free time had to be devoted to family and shooting occasional matches. The board is confident that the pistol side of our club will be well represented by Jim.

Another issue was discussion of submitting a range grant to the NRA to repair the roof of Dillon Sportsman Center. Bryan Hoover, Field Representative for the NRA advised us to submit other ideas for the range grant, since the estimate we have for the roof exceeds the maximum allowed for that grant, and submit a regular foundation grant for the roof repairs. Even though we had a rapidly approaching deadline, Bob McClure and myself we able to take much of the material

gathered by Fred Smith and Rob Ripple and submit a range grant for a wall to separate the pistol range and steel to repair our clay bird storage trailer. Plans were also made to submit a grant for the roof repair next month. The club should hear if we receive these grants next January.

Other issues discussed were efforts to recruit new Range Officers for various matches, minor repairs around the range, the upcoming Greenwing Program, increased outreach to youth groups interested in using the range, and the need to form a group to work on plans for our Memorial Grove of trees and recognition plaque. (*Anyone willing to serve on this committee to recognize our club members that have passed away should contact one of the club officers.*)

Fred Smith gave a mid year report on range and club finances. As a summary we are doing OK in both areas. Anyone wishing to see the detailed reports can contact Fred.
