Tips

This tip is designed for pin shooters but many of you might find it useful. Last months pin match had several shooters swearing at their .22 autos. It was not terribly cold but still pretty chilly. Those of us that have shot wintertime matches for years have come up with a few tips. In cold weather the oil or other lube you may

have on your gun or magazines tends to thicken. If striker or hammer hits were just hard enough in June to touch off your rounds you will get misfires in cold weather. Clean your gun and magazines, choose your lube carefully and use it sparingly. Also if you use some bargain rimfire ammo that has a heavy waxy or oily coating you may run into feeding problems. (Even a cheapskate like me counts on CCI Mini Mags when conditions are bad or going bang is really important.) You will also see some of us oldtimers carrying our loaded .22 magazines in our front pants pockets. A warm magazine functions much better than a cold one. On really miserable days I have

even put a handwarmer in the gun rug with my handgun. If you have been having cold weather problems you might want to try some of these tips.
