WE AT THE DILLON RANGE HAVE AS OUR NUMBER ONE CONCERN YOUR SAFETY.

The Dillon facility is not a controlled range, we simply do not have the manpower to police the range.

Face it, we are all adults and everyone is a range officer. To the best of my knowledge in the approximately 50-year history of this facility there has never been an accident. We would like to keep it this way.

Nobody has ever been accidentally shot with a gun that was not pointed at him or her. Please watch your muzzles. I do not care if it is unloaded, it is rude and bad form if someone is looking down your barrel.

If you are moving a gun around on this range please open the action.

If these two rules are followed no matter what else happens here we all go home at night.

NOW FOR A LIGHTER NOTE.

If you are new here please observe everyone should ground their guns when people are downrange.

The portable target racks live in the back left corner of every bay, under the roof and out of the rain. When we open in the morning there is one in every bay! If you put them back it is helpful but we do not expect to see that happen often, for one thing when you are leaving there may be a lot of shooting going on and I don't expect you to hold up the line to get them.

But for the life of me I cannot understand why we are picking up racks at 100 yards sitting right next to a permanent target rack at 100 yards, and why people carry these racks back to the building or back to the fence when they are done.

We will continue to try to improve the user friendliness of this facility and we hope you have a fun and safe year here. - Rob
