## **NRA Grant Money**

The executive committee met after the regular June monthly meeting to discuss how to allocate the funds received from the NRA grant. After discussing the pros and cons of various expenditures the decision was made to try and purchase two new skeet machines with the intent to add the ability to throw “registered birds” and hold “registered skeet events”. All involved agreed that this approach would help us get the most “bang for the buck” and provide the best opportunity to increase revenue for the range. With luck we should have two operating fields sometime in August.

Some funds were also allocated to furnishing a classroom in the basement. This classroom could be used to provide an instructional area for youth, new shooters, hunter safety classes, concealed carry classes, etc. It is our hope that many of the things necessary for the classroom could be donated and the available grant money would be used to complete our list of necessary equipment.

The annual election of officers took place during the June 8<sup>th</sup> monthly meeting. Current officers were re-elected and Mike Spaulding was elected to the trustee position that was open.
