Tips

There was a time before stainless steel guns and synthetic stocks that many of us flinched at the idea of taking our favorite firearm out in bad weather or other adverse conditions. When we did do it we knew the importance of a thorough cleaning/drying/oiling at the end of the day. Somehow it seemed like a few water drops, fingerprints, or worse; a drop of blood would still find its way onto our gun. An old trick to avoid these problems included a coat of furniture wax on the gunstock (including the barrel channel) and a good coat of automobile wax on all metal parts. Absolute protection? Probably not; but just like expensive automobile paint even a thin layer of protection is a good idea.
