Repairs and Upgrades

The following projects have been completed (or are in progress) by volunteers in the past month:

1. The roof overhang on the rifle and pistol range has been trimmed to better withstand the wind.
2. The platform and steps to the left skeet range high house has been replaced and painted.
3. The left trap house has been lowered, the walls re-enforced, had the concrete floor modified to promote drainage and a new roof installed.
4. Steel target plates have been replaced on the pistol range for use by the public.
5. The roof overhang at the back of the clubhouse has had a support added to help the gutter system work more efficiently. Give a big thanks to all who helped with these projects.

Executive Committee

The committee discussed the needed repairs and made plans to accomplish them. The operation of the range was also discussed and a review of income and expenses was completed. Terry reviewed a trial run of “renting the range” to a group for a graduation

party. This seemed quite successful and a decision was made to open the opportunity to others. A fee of \$75 would rent the rifle and pistol range, clubhouse with restrooms, open grounds, and picnic tables from 5 pm until 10 pm on Saturdays. (Subject to scheduling issues) A discount on clay bird shooting fees is also included. Interested persons should contact Terry Baker.

Also discussed was support for the Ohio IDPA championship. A decision was made to donate \$200 to \$250 worth of services including the use of our large tent, range time, and match fees.
