Repairs and Upgrades

If you have been to the range recently you have probably noticed some volunteer work that is taking place. A group has removed the fill from around the left field trap house. The plan is to lower the height by one or two rows of blocks, reinforce the walls, and repair the roof. The replacement steel targets for the pistol range have been delivered and should soon be installed. Another innovation has been the installation of steel rails to the bottom of the wheeled shooting racks. These racks can be pulled into place with either of our tractors, which saves the physical labor of carrying silhouette rails out from the basement by hand. The rebuilding of our flat bed trailer and the use of the tractors has made the set up of steel matches, IDPA matches, and action rifle matches much quicker and easier. Next week the planned project is the replacement of the steps on the high house of the left skeet field.

Ladies Night

The 2008 Ladies Night was a resounding success and the biggest event so far based on participation. Most of the faces were new and all participants had a very enjoyable evening. Ladies sent around 1500 rounds down range in their quest to identify their personal favorite firearm.
