Rifle and pistol ammo and reloading supplies are going up in price monthly and sometimes weekly. The cost to shoot a match has gone up substantially in the past year. I guess the point I am trying to make with this "doom and gloom" talk is that each of us, the

"hard core" shooters may need to take up some of the slack.

Support the range. Shoot as many matches as you can. Pay for range time and practice. Join a skeet league. Will all this shooting cost more than it did in the past? Definitely. We have held the line on range fees and hope to continue to do so. I know not everyone can afford to shoot as much as they would like, but shoot as much as you can afford in the year to come.
