Club member, Kevin Ferree has asked about using the range for a CCW class to be held on Mon. Oct 27, Wed Oct 29 & Fri Oct 31. We have discussed the use of the range for CCW (Concealed Carry) classes in the past and have now set a policy for anyone wishing to use Dillon to teach the program. The fee would be \$2.00 per hour per student. The course requires 10 hours of class time and 2 hours of range time so this would be about \$24 per student.

In addition, the instructor would be given up to 4 day passes per student to use the rifle & pistol range during normal operating hours for half price.
